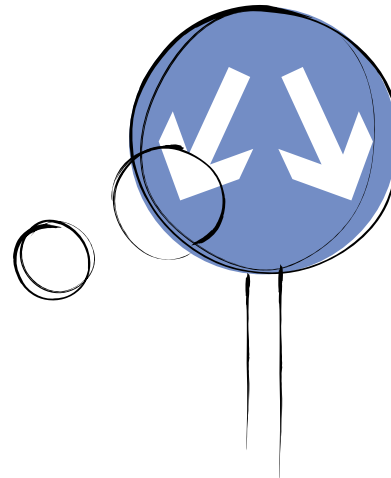

# Antisocial Behaviour Order (ASBO)

## What is an ASBO?

An Anti-Social Behaviour Order. Put simply, a court order that you are to behave in ways that don't upset people or cause bother to them.

## What does it mean?

The court thinks you've caused a lot of nuisance ('anti-social behaviour'). They are determined it has to stop.

## What do I have to do?

Exactly what the court says. It could tell you that you have to stay away from certain places or people and stop doing certain things.

## What if I don't?

The courts are very serious about people who don't keep to these orders!

- You'll be taken back to court
- You could be sent to custody, or fined, amongst other things
- You and your family could lose your home
