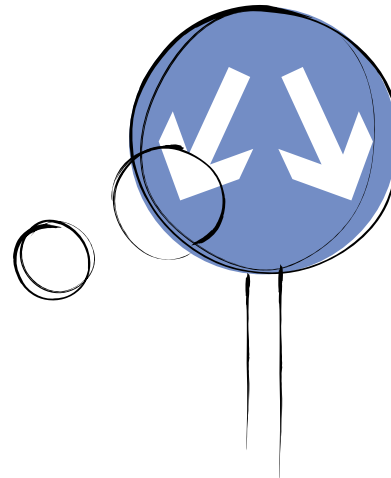

Supervision Order

What is a Supervision Order?

An order of the court that means you have to see someone from the Youth Offending Service, to help you stop offending.

How long does it last?

The court will tell you how long it's for. It can be ended early if things go very well!

How will I know when I have to see someone?

You'll get letters or phone calls.

Where will I see my Supervising Officer?

At your home or our office.

What do I have to do?

Turn up for appointments on time and take part in what's asked of you

What will I do when I am there?

Basically, find ways of making sure you keep out of trouble. Your worker will have lots of ideas – but you need to bring your own!

What are the rules?

You will be expected to:

- Turn up on time and in a fit state
- Keep your appointments
- Take part in the work that's needed
- Be respectful and courteous
- Stay out of trouble
- Let us know if you change where you live

What are my rights?

- To be treated like we expect you to treat us
- Be listened to
- Not to be judged on your past
