Name and Description of Resource

'Cut Up' DVD

Cut - Up is a hard-hitting, short film about the real consequences of knife-crime culture in Britain. The result of a collaboration between Sunderland YOS and Superkrush Films, Cut-up deals with a serious issue made all the more relevant as the young people developed the story-line themselves from a series of drama workshops facilitated by professional actors. The tale reflects with stark honesty the experience of the young people themselves amidst a growing gang and weapons culture generally feared and misunderstood in contemporary society. Designed to be suitable for use with all levels of YOS intervention from Prevention to custody, the film comes with a simple worksheet devised with input from the young people. 'That's Entertainment' DVD

A film made by young people. The film and accompanying workshop pack provides activities and discussion topics for use with young people when considering the problems of under-age drinking, drug use, boredom and anti-social behaviour

Young people were involved in the whole development of the programme. They helped with the script, talking through examples from their own lives. They discussed locations for filming and did some work behind the camera. Most importantly they built the confidence to actually star in the film. They believed in what the finished product would provide for other young people faced with issues similar to the characters in the film.

'Tackle It' Interactive DVD

A film made by young people showing an exploration of myths and realities surrounding substance misuse. The DVD provides workshop facilitators with scenarios and up to date information to use when working with young people to increase their understanding of the issues.

The success of this DVD was the intervention work done prior to filming. Working closely with the Youth Drug and Alcohol Programme (YDAP), educational sessions were delivered to the group so that they had a clearer understanding of the facts. The sessions also provided the film company with the opportunity to explore the fiction. These issues were then combined to make two very powerful short films, which the young people helped script and star in. To ensure other young people had the opportunity to learn the participants wanted to ensure the DVD was more than just a film, and so this 'interactive' DVD has been designed to use with both groups and individuals to both challenge and educate opinions.

Ontrack Board Game

This board game encourages young people to explore risk-taking behaviour through guided discussions on reasons, consequences and possible solutions

Developed by young people at the Ontrack programme the game provides the means to initiate meaningful discussions with young people about the decisions they make by engaging them in a board game format.

The main reason that the Board game is so successful is the concept and design were developed directly by young people working with the Ontrack programme and is therefore appealing to young people and holds their interest. The game is also very flexible and the colour coded issue cards can be chosen to make the game age appropriate. There are also blank card in the pack which allow specific issues relevant to your group to be debated and discussed in a constructive way.
